The whole Dublin Diocese is working with the Building Hope Pastoral Planning Resource, to renew and enliven the mission of the Church in each Parish. The Parish Pastoral Council for Cabra & Cabra West has chosen the 'Welcome' section to focus on this year. There are three other sections 'Servant Leadership', 'Faithfilled Parishes' & 'Social Justice'. We will begin a second one in the autumn.

In looking at our Parishes as being places of welcome it also asks us to look at our outreach to the young, the housebound and those who are our neighbours in the area. It asks us to look at inclusion, evangelisation, accessibility and communication. We have put together a 'Building Hope Tree' and in the area of Welcome we have put in the things that the Pastoral Council have been working on and will continue to develop. Over the next couple weeks we will focus on what has been happening and where there have been challenges.



Take some time to look at the Tree and see what we have been doing to make our Parish a place of welcome. Many of the things were already happening and the most important one is that we say hello to each other and to those new to our Parish.

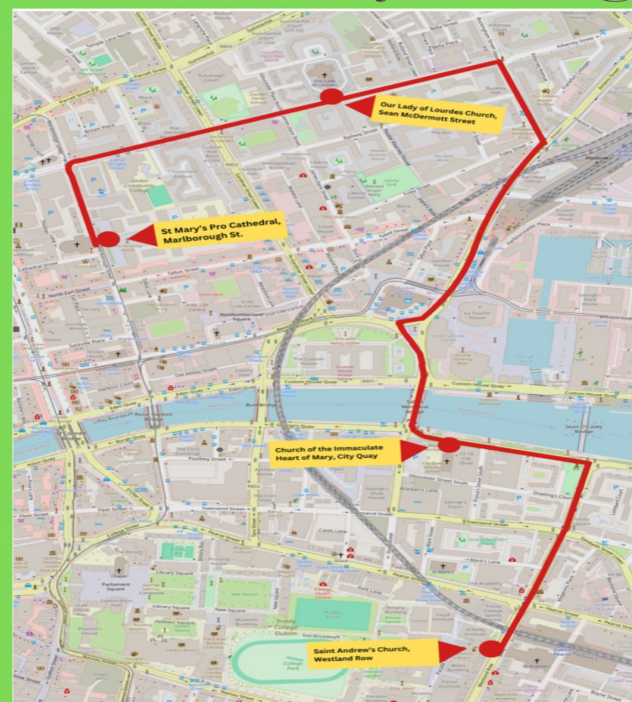
