Archbishop Farrell as Patron of the Schools has given the go ahead for both schools to accept boys and girls. This followed consultation with the staff. Parents, pupils and other schools in the area.

The request for a change to the schools now goes to the Department of Education. We will have to work with them to make the change a reality. This can take between 12 to 18 months or it will be either in 2026 or 2027 that both schools can enrol boys and girls. With the new ADS units in both schools and the on going work to improve the buildings there is a bright future for St. Catherine's and St. Finbarr's schools.
