

Relics of Carlo Acutis 5th to 7th October 2025

Prayer Intentions

There will be a Prayer Intentions Box in front of the Altar where you can place your petitions during these days of prayer. We will hold all of these intentions in prayer together through the intercession of St. Carlo Acutis.

Arrival of the Relics

The relics will arrive at **6:00pm to Christ the King Church on Sunday 5th October**. There will be a Prayer Service which will tell the story of St. Carlo Acutis, reflect on his life and have time for quiet reflection. This will last about an hour after which there will be individual blessings with the relic.

Blessing of Mobile Phones

As patron of the internet and technology we will ask St. Carlo to bless our mobile phones, that they may be used for good and keep us from the harm. This will take place from on **Monday 6th October from 3:30pm to 4:30pm in Most Precious Blood Church**.

Guided Adoration

There will be a Holy Hour on **Monday 6th October from 6:45pm to 7:45pm in Christ the King Church**. We will use the sayings of St. Carlo Acutis and Scripture as we pray before the Blessed Sacrament. We will remember all the intentions that have been placed in the Prayer Box. There will be individual blessings with the relics after the Holy Hour.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

On **Tuesday 7th October from 3:30pm to 5:00pm in Most Precious Blood Church** there will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. During this time a Priest will be available for Confession or prayer guidance in the Oratory of the Church.

Family Blessing and Living Rosary

On **Tuesday 7th October at 6:45pm in Most Precious Blood Church**, there will be a family prayer where we will form a living rosary around the Altar where Carlo's relics will be placed. Each person in the rosary will be asked to pray the Our Father or Hail Mary or Glory Be in turn. These will be printed on cards.

As Carlo's grandmother was a major influence in his faith, we are asking grandparents with their children and grandchildren to take part in this. After the Rosary there will be family blessings with the relic which will be the final part of our days of prayer.
